

## Memo from the Principal

Funding for public education in our school district has been drastically reduced. As a result, money that would ordinarily be granted to your school will not be forthcoming. Given our need to maintain school facilities, purchase supplies, and fund school programs, the school administration has been considering alternative financial sources.

In an effort to meet funding needs, a new school-wide fundraising policy has been established, effective immediately. This week, students will be able to purchase academic points for 10 cents per point. These points, known as Purchase Points, can be used to improve grades on past or future assignments.

Certificates of Purchase Points can be bought from individual teachers. We believe this policy will help us solve our school funding shortage and also enable students to achieve academic success.
